

IH Certificate in Teaching Young Learners and Teenagers (IH CYLT)

What is the IH CYLT?

The main aim of the IH Certificate in Teaching Young Learners and Teenagers (IH CYLT) course is to prepare teachers for working with Young Learners. This means bringing dynamics in the classroom, moving away from “fichinhas” and toward meaningful interaction in the classroom, playful and productive.

What do I need?

Usually, many teachers already have had some form of pre-service training in the teaching English to adults or possible older teens, perhaps even a degree in teaching, using more traditional techniques, but some may not have had previous experience of teaching Young Learners at all.

What does the course include?

Input sessions cover areas such as: lesson planning, classroom management, accuracy and correction techniques, clarifying and practising language, L1 in the classroom, teaching adolescents, material design and selection, and mixed abilities. Above all, this face-to-face version also includes observed and assessed teaching practice.

What kind of certificate will I receive?

The face-to-face IH CYLT course is moderated by Cambridge Assessment English and therefore successful course participants will receive a certificate that includes the Cambridge Assessment English logo. In the end, you will have a certificate with the quality of International House World Organisation, with a tradition of over 70 years combined with the assurance of Cambridge.
